ANNUAL REPORT – 2014

This report covers the activities of the Maryland Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists for the period ending December 31, 2014

The Maryland Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists functions under Health Occupations Article, Title 17, Annotated Code of Maryland. The State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists (the “Board”) is the licensure and certification authority of professional counselors; marriage and family therapists, art therapists, and alcohol and drug counselors in the State of Maryland. The Board is mandated to regulate the practice of professional counseling and therapy in Maryland by licensing and certifying qualified counselors and therapists, promulgating regulations for the practice of professional counseling, marriage and family therapy, art therapy, and alcohol and drug counseling, verifying credentials, issuing licenses and certificates, establishing requirements for and verifying completion of continuing education hours, investigating complaints based on alleged violations of regulations and statutes, formal and informal disciplining of licensees and certificate holders, establishing committees as deemed appropriate to advise the Board, and submit an annual report to the Governor and Secretary.

Mission

The Mission of the Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists is to protect the citizens of Maryland and to promote high quality health care in the field of professional counseling, alcohol and drug counseling, marriage and family therapy, and art therapy.

Meetings

During the year, the Board held 10 formal meetings and committee meetings.

Board Members

The Board consists of 13 members: four licensed clinical professional counselors, three licensed clinical alcohol and drug counselors, three licensed clinical marriage and family therapists, one licensed clinical professional art therapist, and two consumer members.

Finances

The Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists is special funded. Revenues, which support the Board's operations, are generated through licensing and certification fees. No other State funds can be used to support the Board's operations.

The Board generated \$644,150 in revenues in 2014 and its expenditures totaled \$694,103.

Complaints

The Board received 67 complaints in 2014. The number of investigations conducted during the year was 30. The Board issued 19 formal disciplinary actions. All public disciplinary orders can be found on the Board's website at www.dhmfh.maryland.gov/bopc.

Legislation

SB448 - State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists - Cease and Desist Orders and Penalties for Misrepresentation and Practicing Without a License *Passed* (Chapter Number 0061)

This bill authorizes the State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists to issue cease and desist orders or obtain injunctive relief for violations of specified provisions of law; altering a specified penalty; providing that a person who violates specified provisions of law is subject to a civil fine not exceeding \$50,000.

SB694 – Health Occupations - Maryland Behavior Analysts Act – *Passed* (Chapter Number 328)

This bill requires the State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists to regulate the practice of behavior analysis and establishes a Behavior Analyst Advisory Committee. By January 1, 2015, an individual must be licensed by the board to practice behavior analysis in the State. The bill takes effect July 1, 2014.

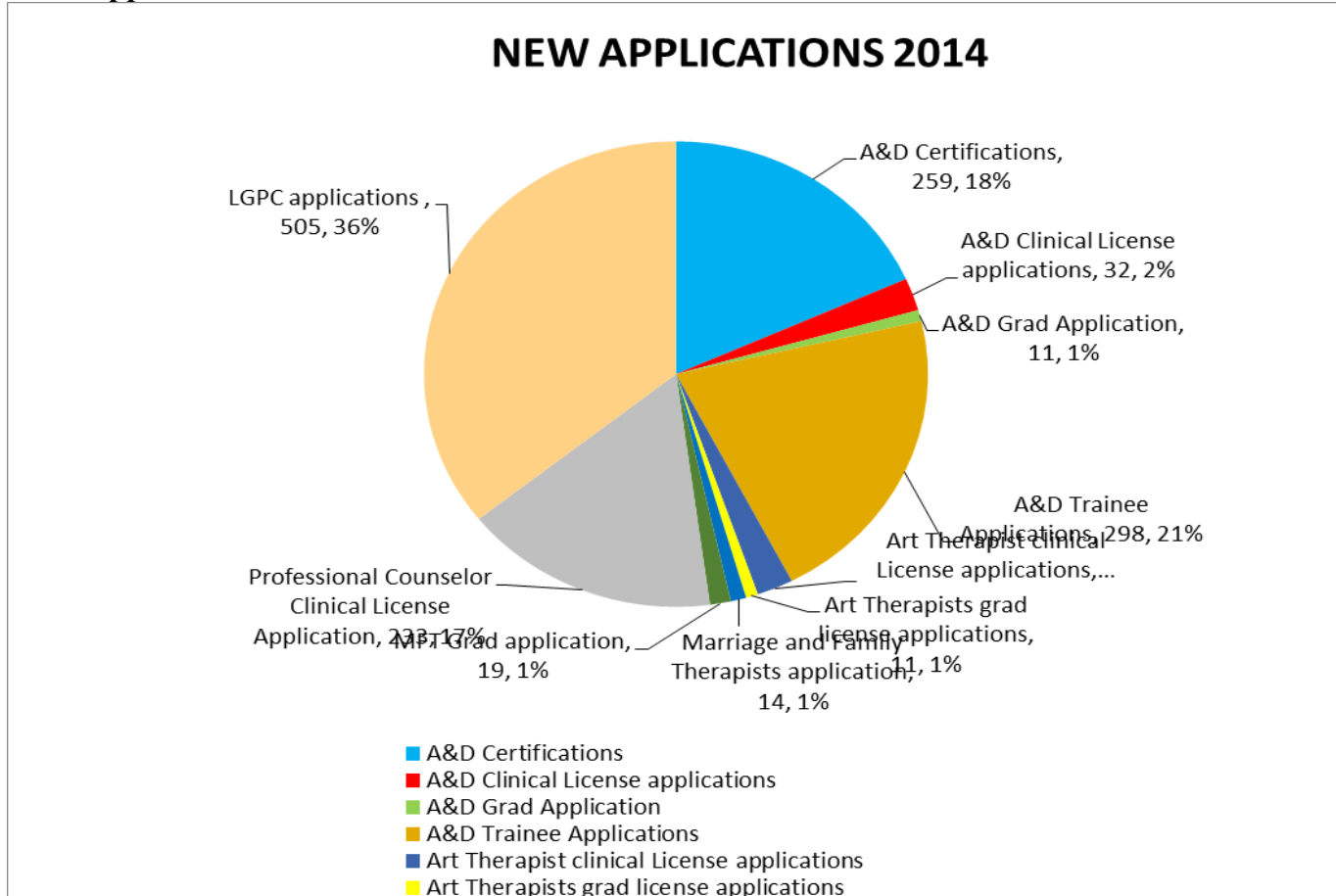

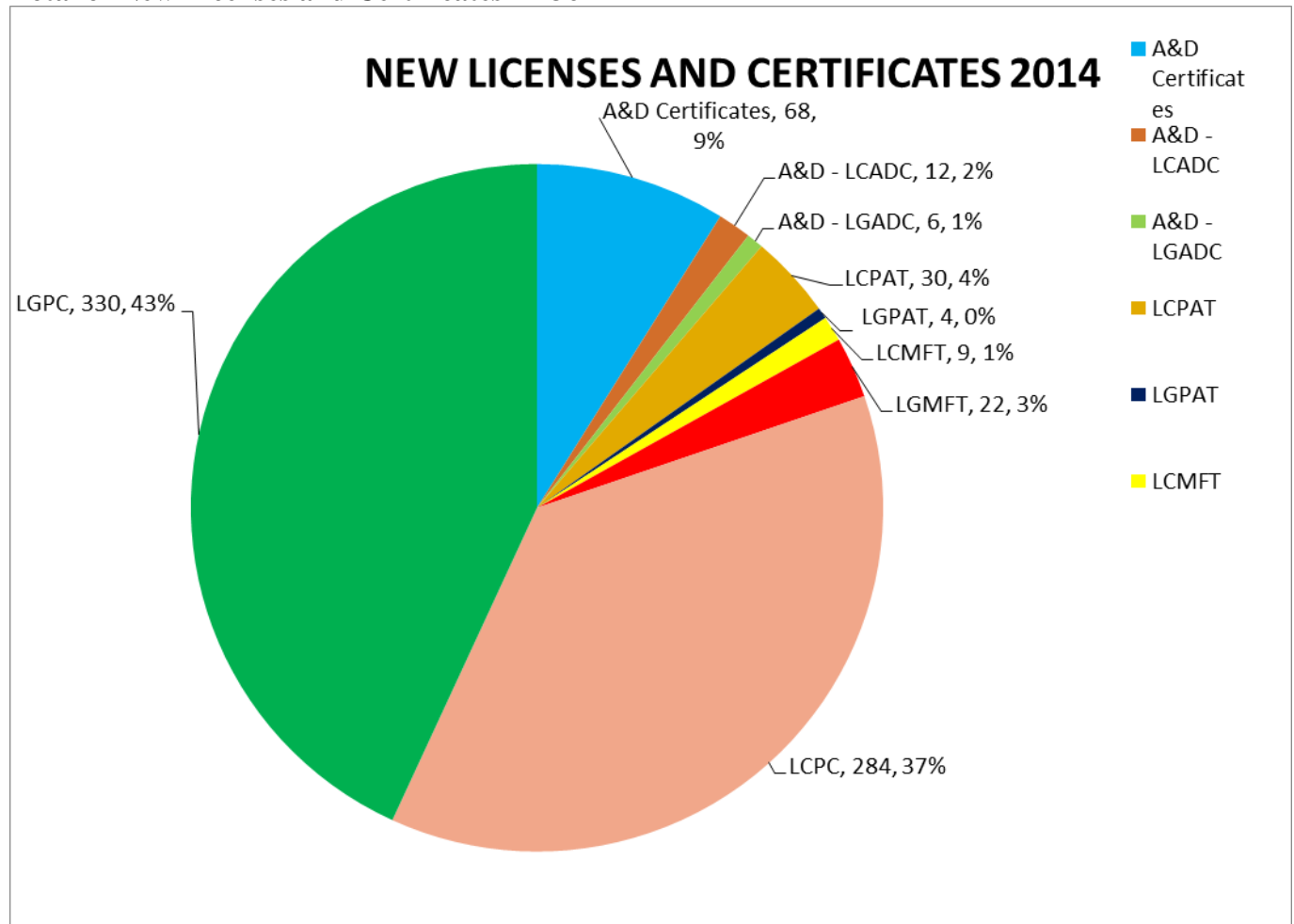

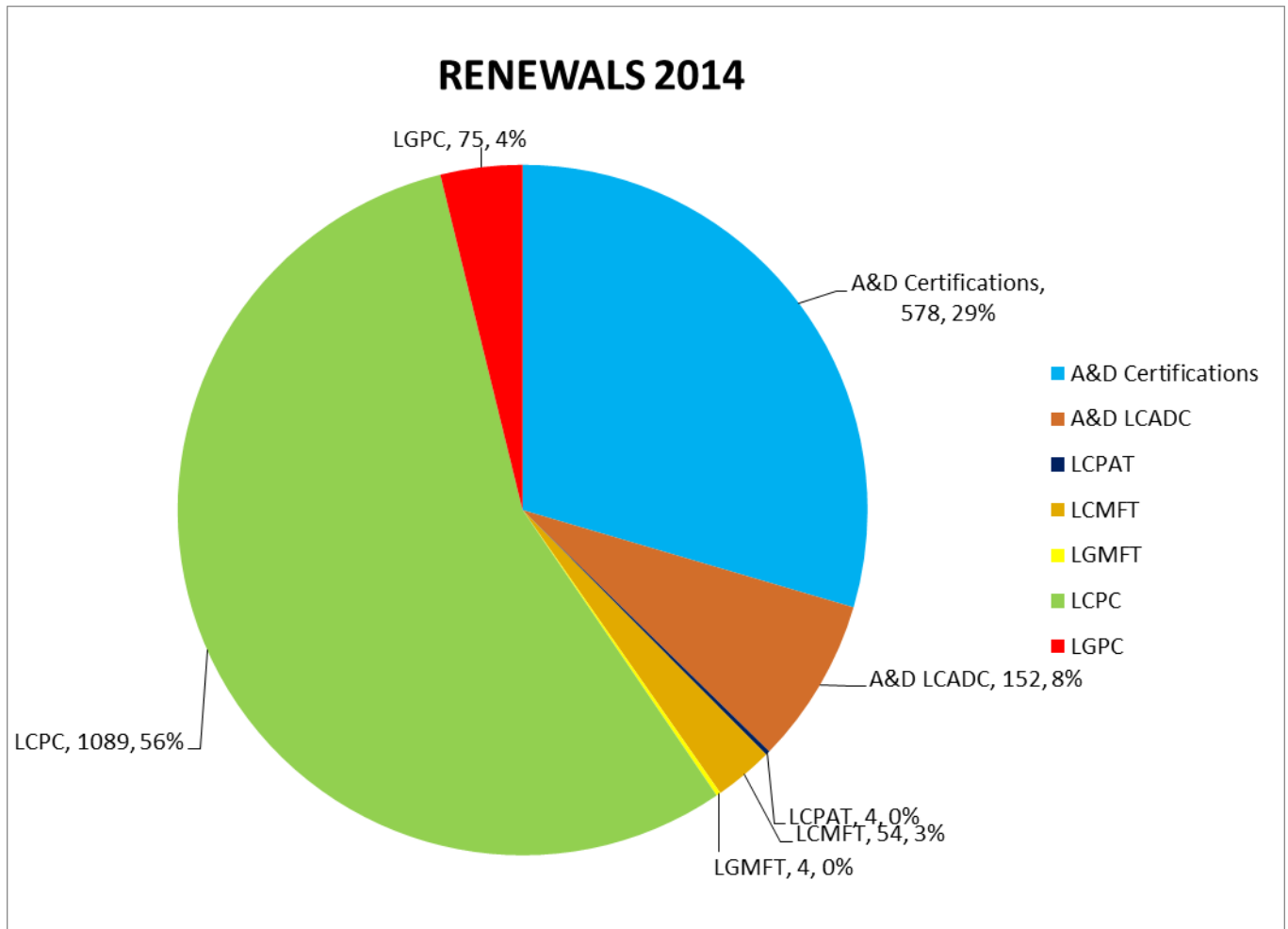
